Pool Design Award: The Small Print!

Any new pool that has been opened since January 2014 is eligible. This can be a large multi function pool for many clients or a small personal pool, or something in between.

Submissions can be made with supporting evidence including photographs and additional information, maximum 2 pages of A4.

All entries will be reviewed by Pool Design Award Team after closing date and a shortlist selected.

Shortlisted pools should expect a visit from member(s) of the Pool Design Award Team for an inspection which follows a set criteria and marking sheet. Extra questions and information including video evidence, may be requested at this time.

Once all the pools have been visited (at least one member of the committee will visit all the shortlisted pools for consistency) then the marking grid will be verified and the winner will be notified. All pools that achieves over 85% or 42/50 on the marking grid will be given a Highly Commended award.

Awards will be presented at the ATACP spring study day, usually held in April in London. Date to be confirmed

The Pool Design Award Team members are from both ATACP (Aquatic Therapy Association of Chartered Physiotherapists) committee and the NCCSPD (National Co-ordinating Committee of Swimming for People with Disabilities). The Shortlisted nominations will go to both full committee meetings before the awards are made.
